- But if we put ourselves sort of in the middle with high frequency of climate gas emissions, we will expect temperatures rising between four to five degrees in Norway, by the end of this century
- If we look at the project we have been investigating (evt looking at), in the Barents Sea, this proves to not really have any economical gain for the society
- The establishment of an attitude in more volunteer matters, where the person takes initiative due to interest in the theme, say for instance, by looking into an organisation with a purpose of learning more about them, then it probably will be more likely to establish a positive attitude towards the content of the message
- If we don't get any more snow, and the glaciers not go back again, then we will have another landscape
- If we are to make a scenario, if we are to end up there, this will be a negative project. Then the expenses will be greater than the income. This means that the society will loose money on the outsourcing
- If you are to establish an attitude where the person is neutral or maybe doesn't really have very much opinion about the subject, then it is important to increase their awareness in a way that is experienced as voluntary as possible for the person "and not forced").
