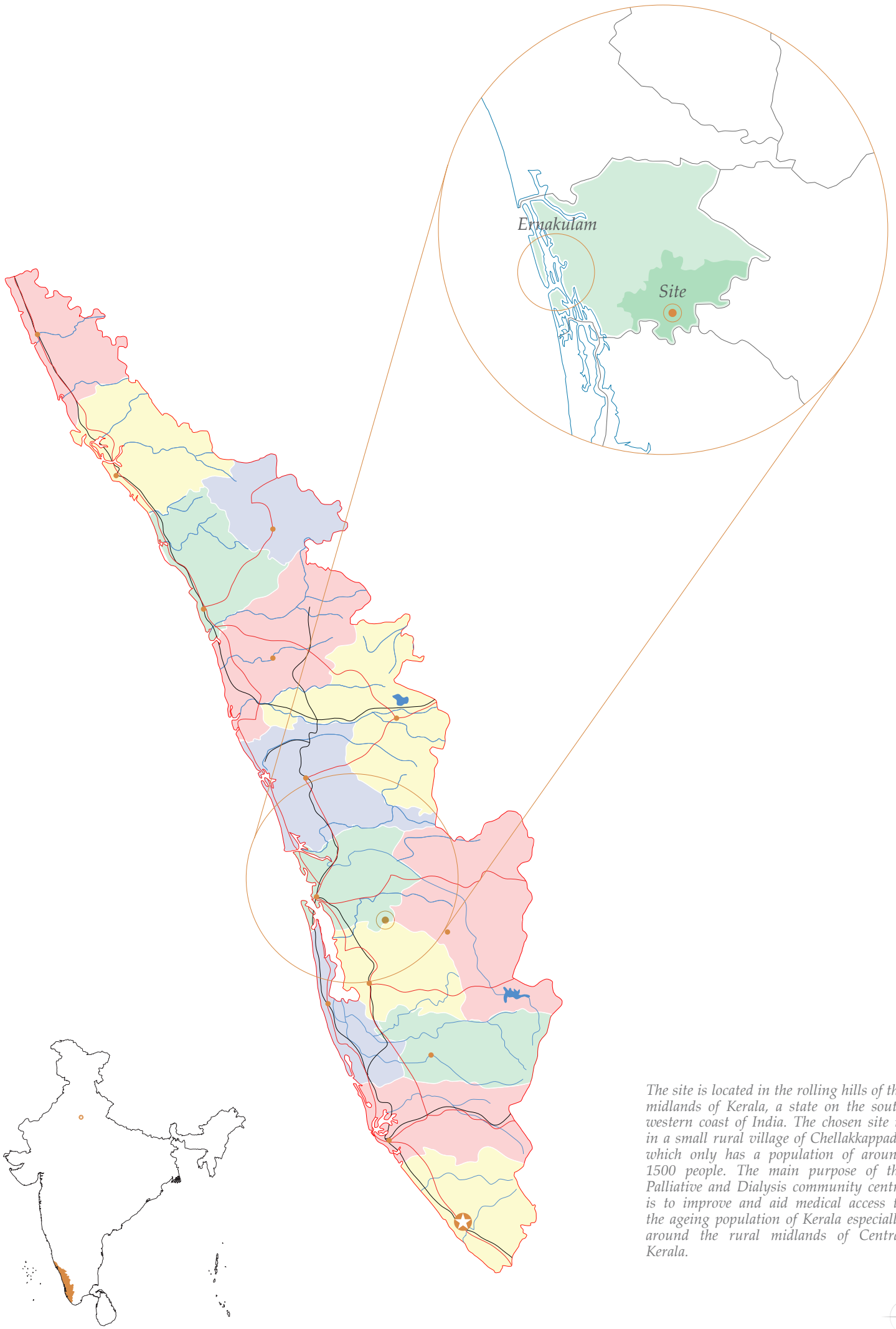

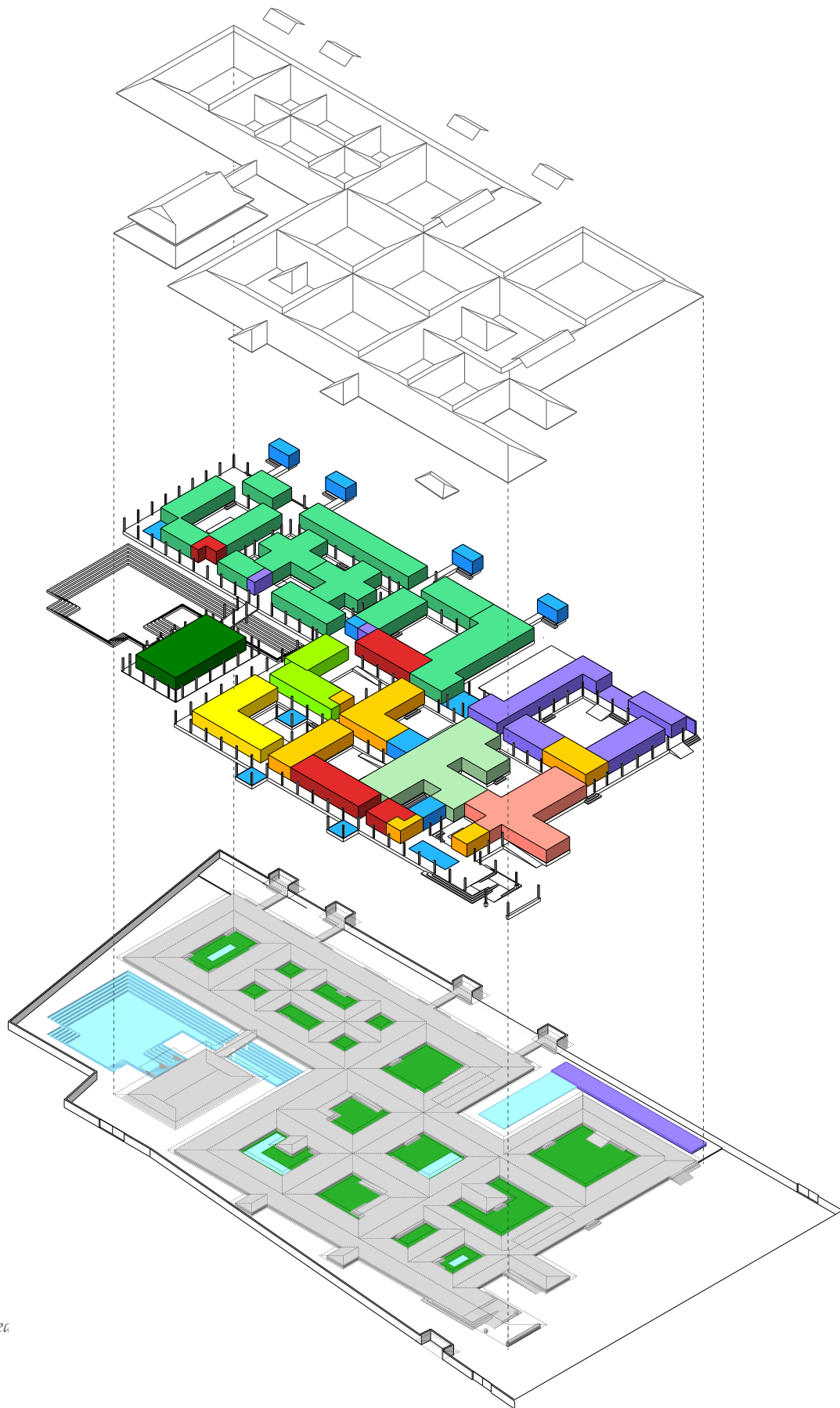

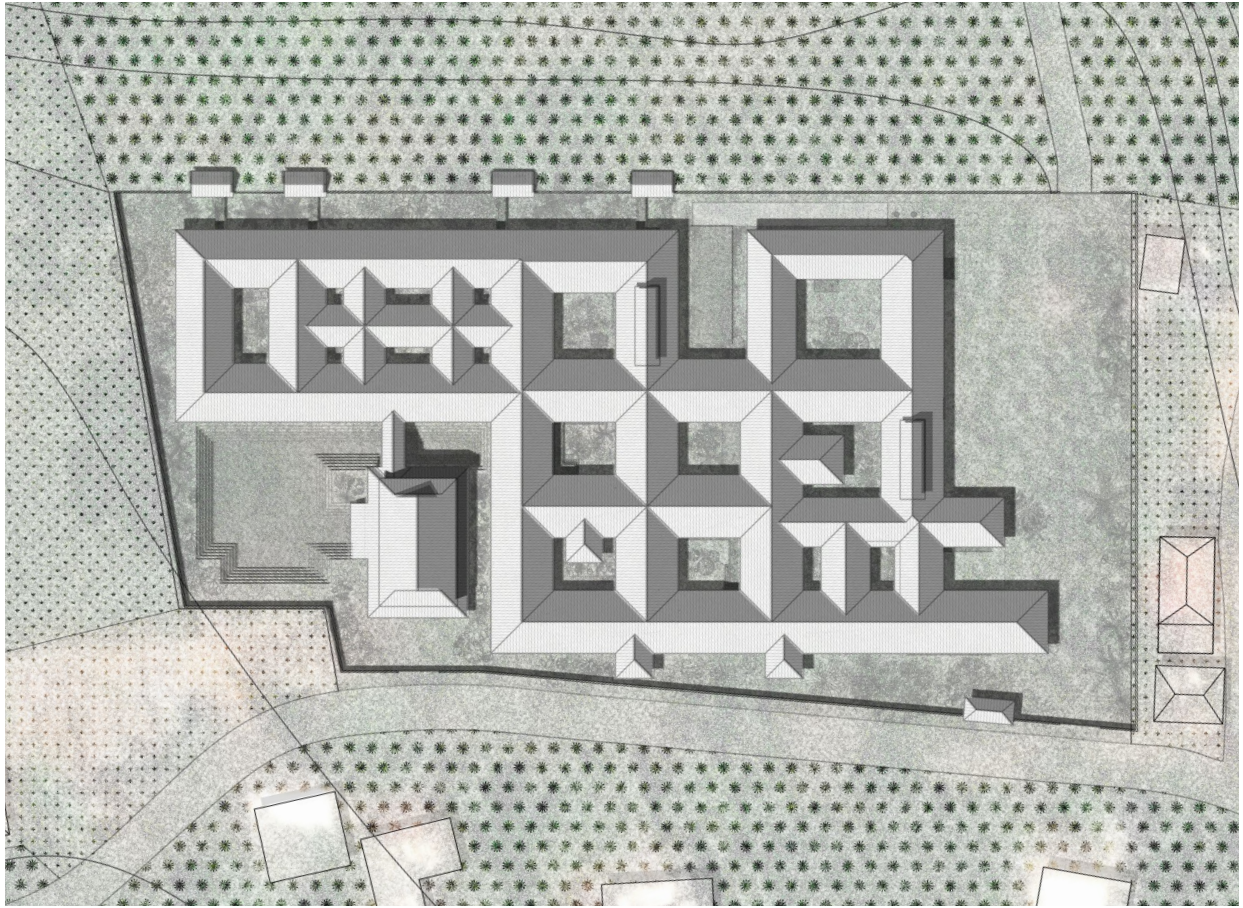




Building Programme
