








The Valley as administrative units The four municipal borroughs defined as 'Groruddalen'



The Valley as a geographic entity - Redrawing the border based on topography




The Valley as visual perception - Redrawing the border based on views




The Valley as an urban system - Redrawing the border based on centralities


Buildings and areas related to museums, galleries, sports, community centers and religious activites are shown with the urbanised area as a backdrop, as a chart of the areas constellations of culture.
