



SYNTHETIC

: constructed by humans with a certain purpose. defined as predictable, chemical, stable, lifeless.




LIVING

: originates from nature with multiple purposes. defined as unpredictable, natural, adaptable, ever-changing



EXTRACTION

: materials taken out of its natural cycles, leaving gaps in nature. defined as decreased, reduced, shrined.




GROWTH

: increasing on nature's own premises. defined as increased, multiple.


FLAT

an equal plane without raised areas. defined as even, smooth, clean.




IRREGULAR

an asymmetrical plane. defined as uneven, textured, patterned.



HUMAN-CENTRIC

: focused on human needs, without considering nature. defined as anthropocentric, inwards, consumeristic.



NATURE-CENTRIC


: encompassing environmental needs.

defined as naturogenic, outwards, biodegradable.



LINEAR

take, use, and discard materials. defined as momentarily, fragmented.



CIRCULAR

: keeping the materials in a loop. defined as long-term, intertwined.
